

Supplied Product	Antibody pair set content:  1. Phospho-ELK1 T417 rabbit polyclonal antibody (20 ul)  In PBS, 150 mM NaCl, pH 7.4 (0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol)  2. ELK1 mouse monoclonal antibody (40 ug)  In 1x PBS, pH 7.2  *Reagents are sufficient for at least 30-50 assays using recommended protocols.
Storage Instruction	Store reagents of the antibody pair set at -20°C or lower. Please aliquot to avoid repeated freeze tha w cycle. Reagents should be returned to -20°C storage immediately after use.

Gene Summary	This gene is a member of the Ets family of transcription factors and of the ternary complex factor (TCF) subfamily. Proteins of the TCF subfamily form a ternary complex by binding to the the serum response factor and the serum reponse element in the promoter of the c-fos proto-oncogene. The protein encoded by this gene is a nuclear target for the ras-raf-MAPK signaling cascade. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding the same protein have been found for this gene.
