Antibody reactive against human CSTA peptide by ELISA and mammalian transfected lysate by We stern Blot.
In 1x PBS, pH 7.4
Store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Up to three rabbit lgG clones of 100 ug each will be delivered to customer.
1. Customer may provide cell or tissue lysate for antibody screening.  2. Rabbit monoclonal antibody generated by ARM technology is amenable to antibody engineering in cluding F(ab) <sub>2</sub> , lgG, scFv and different Fc and non-Fc conjugates per customer request.

Gene Summary	The cystatin superfamily encompasses proteins that contain multiple cystatin-like sequences. So me of the members are active cysteine protease inhibitors, while others have lost or perhaps nev er acquired this inhibitory activity. There are three inhibitory families in the superfamily, including t he type 1 cystatins (stefins), type 2 cystatins, and kininogens. This gene encodes a stefin that func tions as a cysteine protease inhibitor, forming tight complexes with papain and the cathepsins B, H, and L. The protein is one of the precursor proteins of cornified cell envelope in keratinocytes and plays a role in epidermal development and maintenance. Stefins have been proposed as progn ostic and diagnostic tools for cancer. [provided by RefSeq
