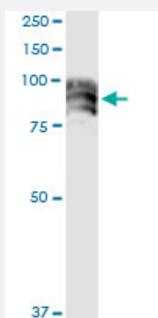

1. Antibody pair for IP: rabbit polyclonal anti-DPP4 (300 ul)
2. Antibody pair for WB: mouse purified polyclonal anti-DPP4 (50 ug)

Storage Instruction

Store reagents of the antibody pair set at -20°C or lower. Please aliquot to avoid repeated freeze thaw cycle. Reagents should be returned to -20°C storage immediately after use.
