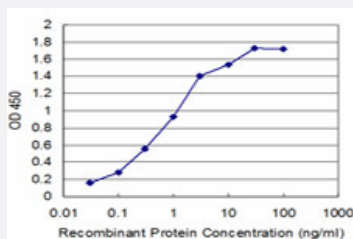

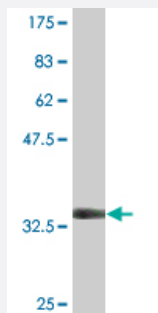

Gene Summary	The SLC11A2 gene encodes a divalent metal transporter (DMT1), which carries iron, manganese, cobalt, nickel, cadmium, lead, copper, and zinc. DMT1 participates in cellular iron absorption at the luminal surface of the duodenum as well as in other areas of the body (Hubert and Hentze, 2002 [PubMed 12209011]; Ludwiczek et al., 2007 [PubMed 17293870]).[supplied by OMIM]
