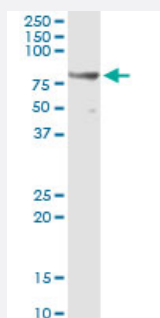

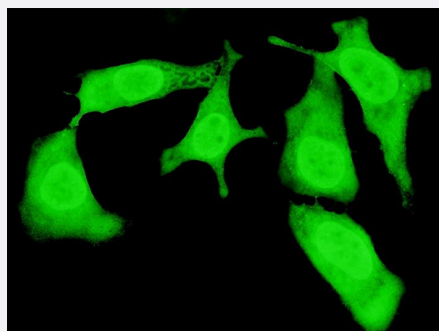

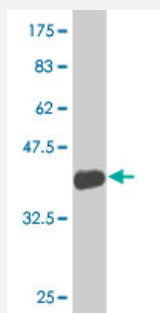
Immunoprecipitation
