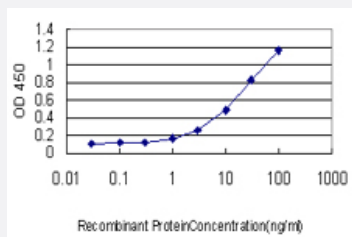

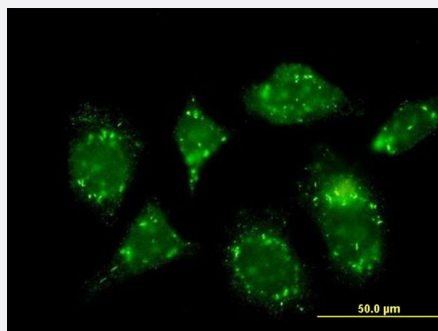

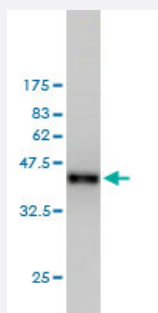
Sandwich ELISA (Recombinant protein)
