

Gene Summary	This gene encodes a protein containing multiple ankyrin domains and two IQ calmodulin-binding d omains. The encoded protein may function in renal tubular development and function, and in left-ri ght axis determination. This protein interacts with nephrocystin and infers a connection between p rimary cilia function and left-right axis determination. A similar protein in mice interacts with calmo dulin. Mutations in this gene have been associated with nephronophthisis type 2. Two transcript v ariants encoding distinct isoforms have been identified for this gene. [provided by RefSeq
