



Storage Buffer	1X Sample Buffer (50 mM Tris-HCl, 2% SDS, 10% glycerol, 300 mM 2-mercaptoethanol, 0.01% Bro mophenol blue)

Gene Summary	This gene encodes a member of the ALEX family of proteins which may play a role in tumor suppr ession. The encoded protein contains a potential N-terminal transmembrane domain and a single Armadillo (arm) repeat. Other proteins containing the arm repeat are involved in development, ma intenance of tissue integrity, and tumorigenesis. This gene is closely localized with other family m embers on the X chromosome. Three transcript variants encoding the same protein have been id entified for this gene. [provided by RefSeq
