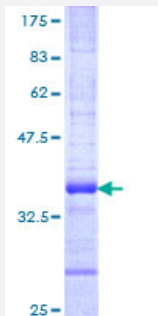

Storage Instruction	Store at -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
