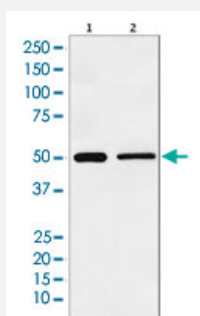

Specification

Product Description	Rabbit monoclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of human HAVCR1.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to human HAVCR1.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Human, Mouse
Specificity	The antibody reacts with human, mouse HAVCR1, in native form and recombinant. Superfamily members of HAVCR1 are not reactive to this antibody.
Form	Liquid
Purification	Affinity purification
Isotype	IgG
Recommend Usage	Western Blot (1:500-1:2000) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS, 150 mM NaCl, pH 7.4 (50% glycerol, 0.02% sodium azide).

Storage Instruction

Store at 4°C for short term storage. For long term storage store at -20°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Note

This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
