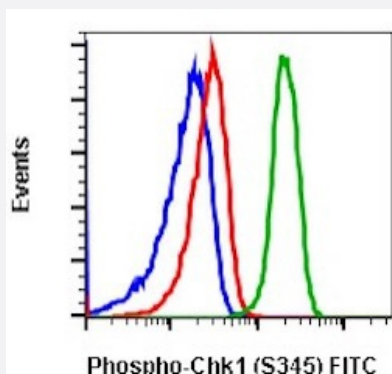

Storage Buffer	In PBS, pH 7.4 (0.2% BSA, 0.09% sodium azide).
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C.
