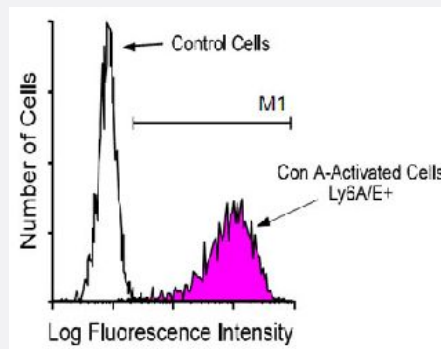

Flow Cytometry

BALB/c spleen cells were activated by incubation for 48 hours with concanavalin-A. After harvesting, the cells were stained with Ly6a monoclonal antibody, clone D7 (FITC) (Cat # MAB5757), and activated cells were gated and analyzed on a FACScan™ flow cytometer.

Recommend Usage	Flow Cytometry (0.2 ug/10 ⁶ cells) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.09% sodium azide)

Storage Instruction

Store in the dark at 4°C. Do not freeze.
Avoid prolonged exposure to light.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
