Detection of Glo1 protein by Western blotting with Glo1 monoclonal antibody, clone 6F10 (Cat # MAB6768).

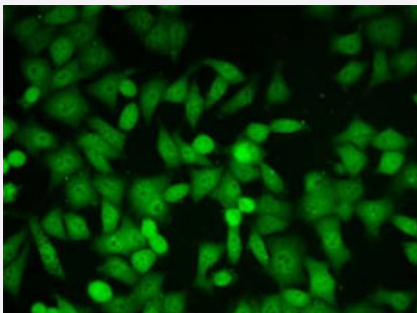
Samples are whole cell extracts :

Lane1 : GCOS-1 (simian).

Lane2 : GL929 (mouse).

Lane3 : GHeLa (human).

Mouse Glo1 shows a single band of 27 kDa while human and simian ones show 29 kDa.

Storage Instruction	Store at -20°C. For long term storage store at -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
