Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (1:25-1:50) Western Blot (1:25-1:50) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from tissue culture supernatant (0.09% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C on dry atmosphere. After reconstitution with steril distilled water, Store at 4°C for at least two months. For long term storage store at -20°C or below. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.

Gene Summary	The protein encoded by this gene is one of the four known components of the sarcoglycan complex, which is a subcomplex of the dystrophin-glycoprotein complex (DGC). DGC forms a link between the F-actin cytoskeleton and the extracellular matrix. This protein is expressed most abundantly in skeletal and cardiac muscle. Mutations in this gene have been associated with autosomal recessive limb-girdle muscular dystrophy and dilated cardiomyopathy. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been observed for this gene. [provided by RefSeq]
