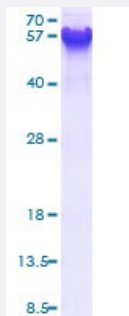

Product Description	Human SPP1 (NP_001035147, 17 a.a. - 314 a.a.) partial recombinant protein with His tag expressed in <i>Escherichia coli</i> .

Preparation Method	<i>Escherichia coli</i> expression system
Purity	> 90% by SDS-PAGE
Endotoxin Level	< 1 EU per 1 ug of protein (determined by LAL method).
Activity	Measured by the ability of the immobilized protein to support the adhesion of HEK293 human embryonic kidney cells. When cells are added to OPN coated plates 10 ug/mL. This effect is more to 40%.
Quality Control Testing	3 ug by SDS-PAGE under reducing condition and visualized by coomassie blue stain.
Recommend Usage	SDS-PAGE The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In 20 mM Tris-HCl buffer, 2 mM EDTA, pH 7.5 (1 mM DTT, 10% glycerol).

Storage Instruction

Store at 2°C to 8°C for 1 week. For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
