

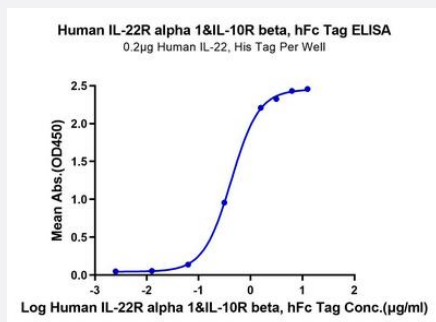

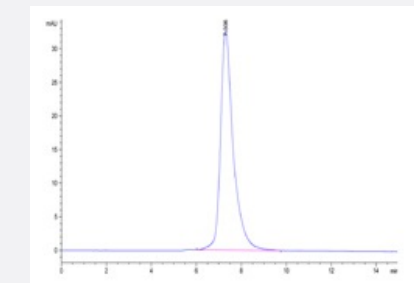

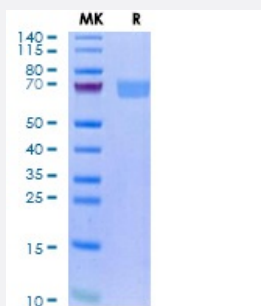

This gene and three other int erferon receptor genes, IFAR2, IFNAR1, and IFNGR2, form a class II cytokine receptor gene clust er located in a small region on chromosome 21. [provided by RefSeq
