Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from 10 mM potassium phosphate, 75 mM NaCl, 50% (v/v) glycerol, pH 7.2 (0.01% (w/v) sodium azide, 10 mg/mL BSA (ImmunoglobulLyophilized from and Protease free))
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C on dry atmosphere. After reconstitution with 1 mL of deionized water, store at -20°C or lower. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which shoul d be handled by trained staff only.
