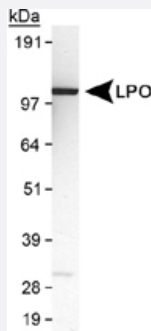

Western blot analysis of LPO in MDA-MB-231 cell lysate using LPO polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB12397).

Specification

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of LPO.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to amino acids 300-400 of human LPO.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Bovine, Human, Primates
Form	Liquid
Recommend Usage	Western Blot (0.5-2 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (30% glycerol, 0.09% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C for short term. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
