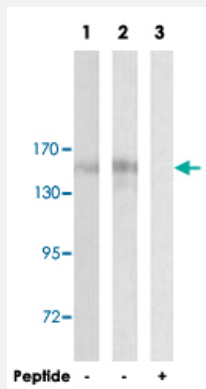

Western blot analysis of extracts from HUVEC cells (Lane 1) and COS cells (Lane 2 and lane 3), using POLR3A polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB17698). Peptide "+" means "with peptide blocking".

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of POLR3A.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to internal of human POLR3A.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Human
Specificity	This antibody detects endogenous levels of total POLR3A protein.
Form	Liquid
Recommend Usage	Western Blot (1:500-1:1000) ELISA (1:5000) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS, pH 7.4 (150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol)
Storage Instruction	Store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
