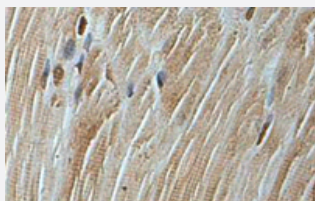

Recommend Usage	ELISA (1:5000-1:20000) Immunohistochemistry (1:50-200) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In serum (0.02% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C for three months. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
