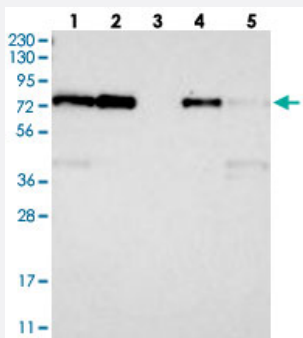

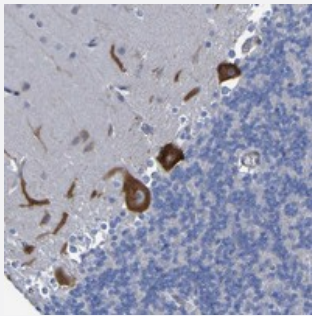

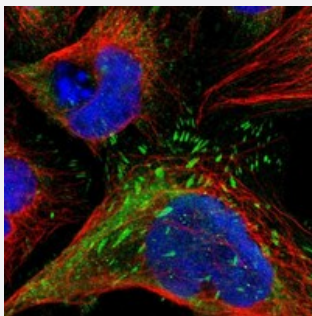
Western Blot

Western blot analysis of Lane 1: RT-4, Lane 2: U-251 MG, Lane 3: Human Plasma, Lane 4: Liver, Lane 5: Tonsil with LPP polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB20536) at 1:250-1:500 dilution.



Immunohistochemistry (Formalin/PFA-fixed paraffin-embedded sections)

Immunohistochemical staining of human cerebellum with LPP polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB20536) shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in purkinje cells at 1:50-1:200 dilution.



Immunofluorescence

Immunofluorescent staining of human cell line U-2 OS with LPP polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB20536) at 1-4 ug/mL dilution shows positivity in cytoplasm, focal adhesions.

Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (1:50-1:200) Western Blot (1:250-1:500) Immunofluorescence (1-4 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS, pH 7.2 (40% glycerol, 0.02% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
