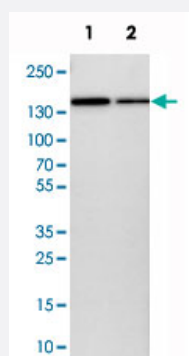

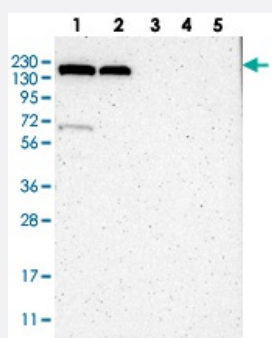

Western blot analysis of cell lysates with KIAA0355 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB20743) at 1:250-1:500 dilution.

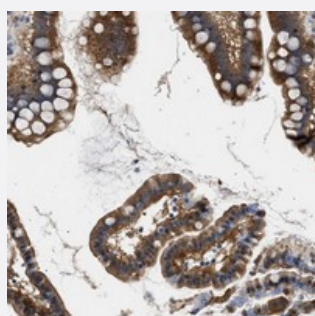
Lane 1 : NIH/3T3
