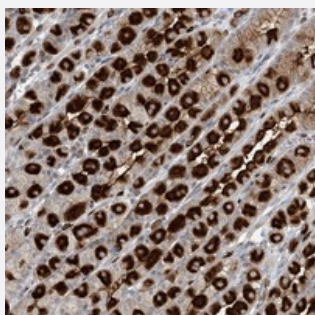

Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
