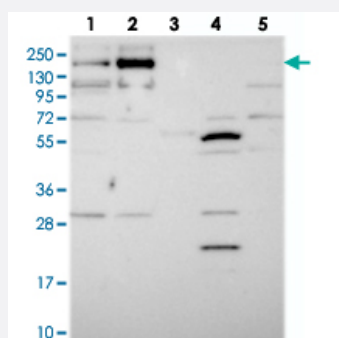

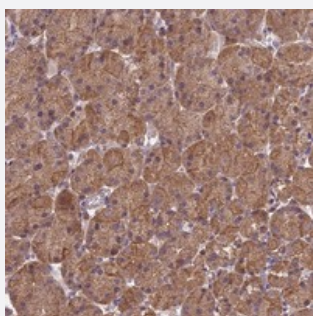

Western Blot

Western blot analysis of Lane 1: RT-4, Lane 2: U-251 MG, Lane 3: Human Plasma, Lane 4: Liver, Lane 5: Tonsil with TMEM2 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB24370) at 1:250-1:500 dilution.



Immunohistochemistry (Formalin/PFA-fixed paraffin-embedded sections)

Immunohistochemical staining of human stomach with TMEM2 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB24370) shows moderate cytoplasmic positivity in glandular cells at 1:50-1:200 dilution.

Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (1:50-1:200) Western Blot (1:250-1:500) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS, pH 7.2 (40% glycerol, 0.02% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
