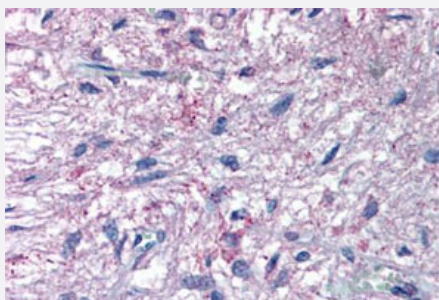

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of GPR50.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to 20 amino acids at C-terminus of human GPR50.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Human
Specificity	BLAST analysis of the peptide immunogen showed no homology with other human proteins.
Form	Liquid
Purification	Immunoaffinity chromatography
Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (Formalin/PFA-fixed paraffin-embedded sections) (3-28 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.09% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
