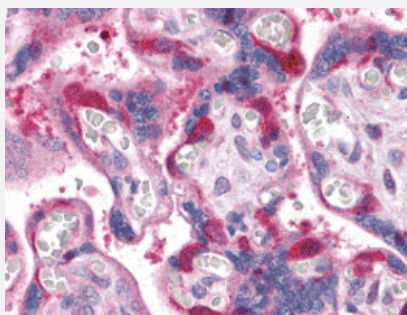

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of RIPK1.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to 14 amino acids at C-terminus of human RIPK1.

Purification	Peptide affinity purification
Concentration	1 mg/mL
Isotype	IgG
Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (10 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.02% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C for three months. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
