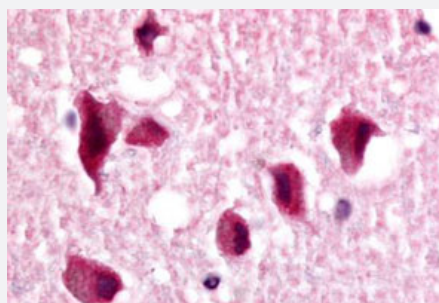

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of NR2E1.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to 15 amino acid at N-terminus of human NR2E1.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Bovine, Dog, Horse, Human, Monkey, Pig, Rabbit
Specificity	BLAST analysis of the peptide immunogen showed no homology with other human proteins.
Form	Liquid
Purification	Immunoaffinity chromatography
Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (Formalin/PFA-fixed paraffin-embedded sections) (5.5 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.09% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
