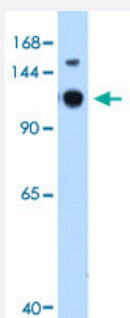

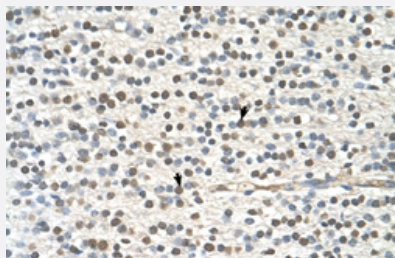

Recommend Usage	Immunohistochemistry (Formalin/PFA-fixed paraffin-embedded sections) (4-8 ug/mL) Western Blot (0.25 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.
Storage Buffer	In PBS (2% sucrose, 0.09% sodium azide).
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -20°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
