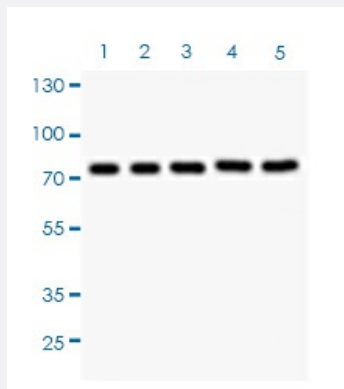

Immunoblot analysis of cell lysates. Lane 1 : human Jurkat whole cell lysate. Lane 2 : human 22RV1 whole cell lysate. Lane 3 : human MCF-7 whole cell lysate. Lane 4 : human Hela whole cell lysate. Lane 5 : human A549 whole cell lysate.

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against partial recombinant Human RIPK1.
Immunogen	Recombinant protein corresponding to amino acids 316 - 671 at C-terminus region of <i>Escherichia coli</i> -derived human RIPK1.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Human
Form	Lyophilized
Storage Buffer	In buffer containing 0.9 mg NaCl, 0.2 mg Na ₂ HPO ₄ (0.05 mg sodium azide, 5 mg BSA)
Storage Instruction	Store at -20°C for one year. After reconstitution, at 4°C for one month. It can also be aliquotted and stored frozen at -20°C for six months. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
