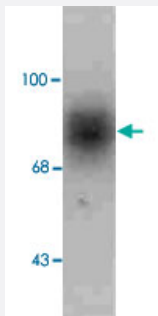

Storage Buffer	In 10 mM HEPES, 150 mM NaCl, pH 7.5 (50% glycerol, 10% BSA)

Storage Instruction

Store at -20°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Gene Summary The dopamine transporter (DAT1) mediates the active reuptake of dopamine from the synapse and is a principal regulator of dopaminergic neurotransmission. The DAT1 gene has been implicated in human disorders such as parkinsonism, Tourette syndrome, and substance abuse (Vandenberg et al., 1992 [PubMed 1359373]).[supplied by OMIM]
