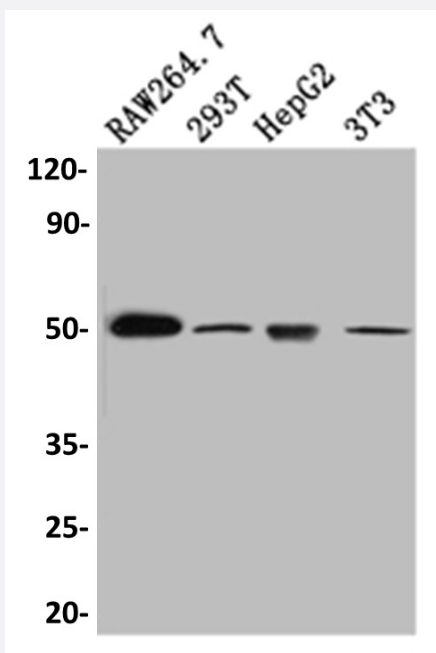

Storage Instruction	Store at -20°C or -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
