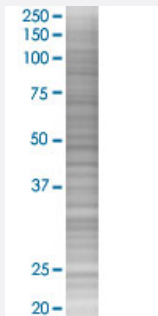

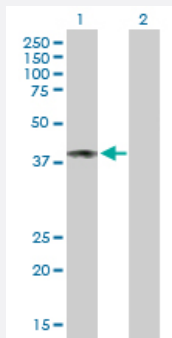

1X Sample Buffer (50 mM Tris-HCl, 2% SDS, 10% glycerol, 300 mM 2-mercaptoethanol, 0.01% Bromophenol blue)

Gene Summary

BLAST1 is the designation used for an activation-associated cell surface glycoprotein of 40 to 45 kD expressed primarily in mitogen-stimulated human lymphocytes. The protein sequence predicted by the cDNA encoding BLAST1 indicates that BLAST1 is a member of the immunoglobulin supergene family. Yokoyama (1991) identified the BLAST1 activation/adhesion molecule as CD48.[s applied by OMIM
