

Storage Buffer	50 mM Tris-HCl, 10 mM reduced Glutathione, pH=8.0 in the elution buffer.
Storage Instruction	Store at -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Gene Summary	This gene encodes a member of the mammalian PIAS [protein inhibitor of activated STAT-1 (sign all transducer and activator of transcription-1)] family. This member contains a putative zinc-bindin g motif and a highly acidic region. It inhibits STAT1-mediated gene activation and the DNA bindin g activity, binds to Gu protein/RNA helicase II/DEAD box polypeptide 21, and interacts with andro gen receptor (AR). It functions in testis as a nuclear receptor transcriptional coregulator and may h ave a role in AR initiation and maintenance of spermatogenesis. [provided by RefSeq
