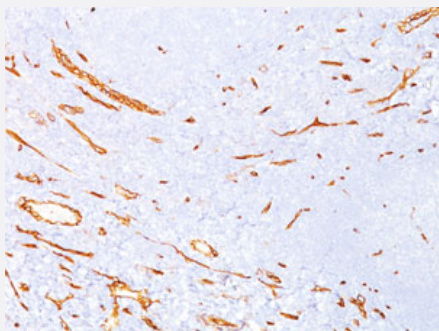

Store at 4°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
