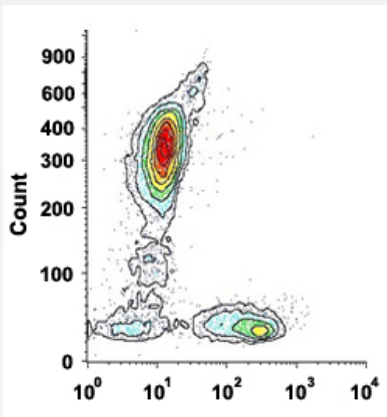

Storage Instruction	Store in the dark at 4°C. Avoid prolonged exposure to light.
