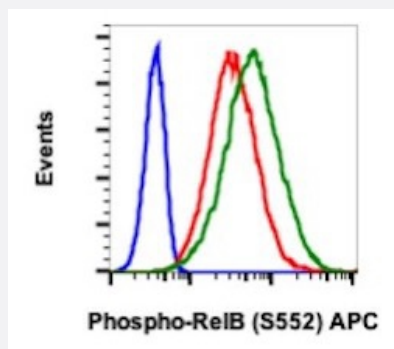

Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C.
