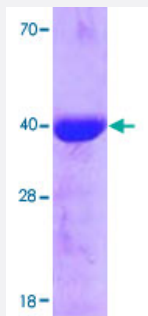

Activity	Specific activity is > 210 nmoles/min/ug, and is defined as the amount of enzyme that cleaves 1umol e of suc-AAFP-pNA per minute at 1°C in Tris-HCl pH 8.0 using chymotrypsin.
Quality Control Testing	Loading 3 ug protein in 15% SDS-PAGE
Storage Buffer	In 20 mM Tris, pH 8.0.
Storage Instruction	Store at 2°C to 8°C for 1 week. For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Gene Summary	The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the peptidyl-prolyl cis-trans isomerase (PPIase) family. PPIases catalyze the cis-trans isomerization of proline imidic peptide bonds in oligopeptides and accelerate the folding of proteins. This protein contains a highly conserved cyclophilin (CYP) domain as well as an RNA-binding domain. It was shown to possess PPIase and protein folding activities and also exhibit RNA-binding activity. Three alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been observed.
