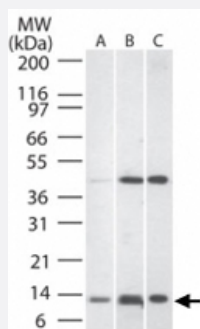

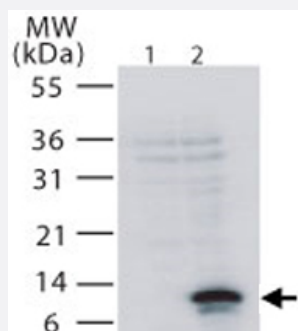

Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.05% BSA, 0.05% sodium azide)

Storage Instruction

Store at 4°C. For long term storage store at -20°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
