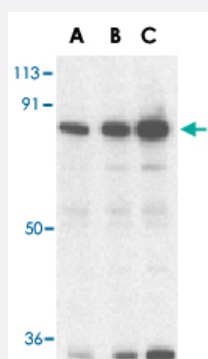

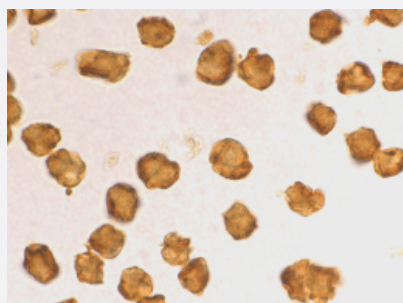

Western blot analysis of SARM1 in Daudi cell lysates with SARM1 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB12917) at (A) 0.5, (B) 1, and (C) 2 ug/mL .

Immunocytochemistry staining of Daudi cells using SARM1 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB12917) at 2 ug/mL .

Specification

Product Description	Rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against synthetic peptide of SARM1.
Immunogen	A synthetic peptide corresponding to C-terminus of human SARM1.
Host	Rabbit
Reactivity	Human, Mouse
Form	Liquid
Recommend Usage	Western Blot (0.5-2 ug/mL) The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.

Storage Buffer	In PBS (0.02% sodium azide)
Storage Instruction	Store at 4°C for three months and -20°C for up to one year. Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
Note	This product contains sodium azide: a POISONOUS AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE which should be handled by trained staff only.
