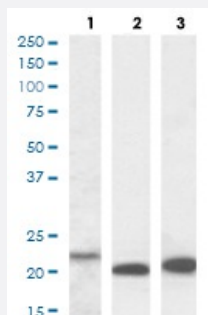

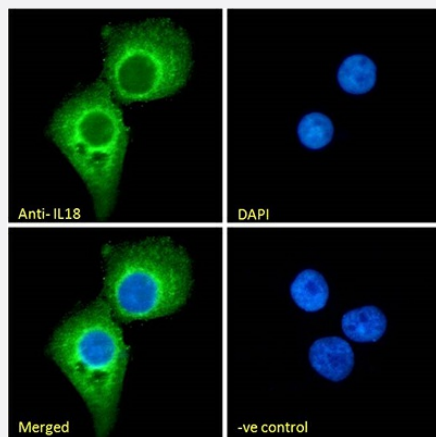

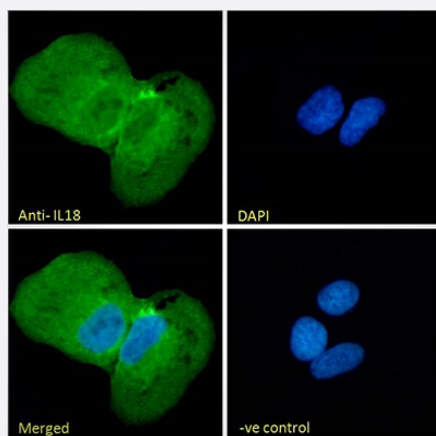
Western Blot (Cell lysate)

IL18 polyclonal antibody (Cat # PAB14391) (0.1 ug/mL) staining of HeLa (1), (2ug/ml) A431 (2) and U2OS (3) cell lysate (35 ug protein in RIPA buffer). Detected by chemiluminescence.



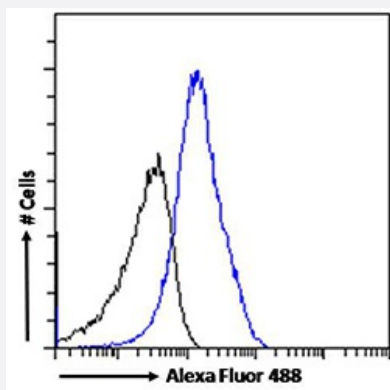
Immunofluorescence

Primary incubation 1hr (10 ug/mL) followed by Alexa Fluor 488 secondary antibody (2 ug/mL), showing Golgi and cytoplasmic staining. The nuclear stain is DAPI (blue). Negative control: Unimmunized goat IgG (10 ug/mL) followed by Alexa Fluor 488 secondary antibody (2 ug/mL).

Gene Summary

The protein encoded by this gene is a proinflammatory cytokine. This cytokine can induce the IFN-gamma production of T cells. The combination of this cytokine and IL12 has been shown to inhibit IL4 dependent IgE and IgG1 production, and enhance IgG2a production of B cells. IL-18 binding protein (IL18BP) can specifically interact with this cytokine, and thus negatively regulate its biological activity. [provided by RefSeq]
