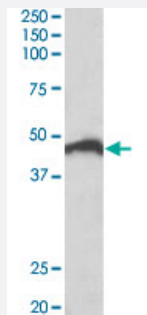

Store at -20°C.
Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
